

Ferraris Estate

Established in 2001 by Claude and Paula Ferraris, Ferraris Estate is a boutique producer of premium Shiraz and Rosé. The fruit for Ferraris Estate wines comes from the family's vineyard on Broke Road in the heart of Pokolbin, NSW. Planted into predominantly sandy—loam soil, the vines produce limited quantities of premium fruit which is made into a medium bodied Hunter style Shiraz and a fruity Rosé which is perfect for warm summer evenings.

Winemaking

While it is true that great wines are 'made in the vineyard' a very important contributor to the success of Ferraris Estate is winemaker Rhys Eather. Rhys studied and trained internationally and has gained the experience necessary to craft the fruit from Ferraris Estate into wines that are medium bodied, Hunter in style and a pleasure to imbibe.

Wine Reviews

Ferraris Estate 2003 Shiraz was the first wine to be released onto the market and enjoyed a positive response from wine critics and consumers alike. Such was the response that the wine sold out very quickly, a fantastic result, our first year. "Ripe plummy, tarry, violetty fruit expression on the nose. Poised, even, balanced, fine red in the mouth, a stencil on the nose, with a tarry—earthy finish and excellent fruit weight. Bright. Attractive. The 2004 vintage yielded more fruit resulting in greater production of Shiraz this enabled us to cellar a quantity for later release.

From the Shiraz grapes a Rosé was produced in 2004, so popular that it sold out quickly, proving the appeal of Rosé to consumers who enjoy a lighter, chilled red wine.

The 2005 Ferraris Shiraz has been rated highly by wine critics and appreciated by consumers. The wine is refined, balanced and all that a good Hunter Shiraz should be.
